

# Term 3 Year 1 Home learning

Your Home learning for this term will be a series of tasks, based on our topics, 'Our Local Area' and 'Materials' and other exciting things which we are learning about throughout this term. Each task has a points grading. Children must score a minimum of 25 points between now and the end of term 3 to secure a certificate.

**Children must complete one task each week.**

## Useful tips:

- For our most enthusiastic children, who like to produce multiple pieces of Home learning in a week, this is absolutely fine! However, please ensure the same high standard is maintained and a piece still comes in weekly.
- When using a website to complete research, please ensure that children make some notes based on their findings, rather than print directly off of the website!
- Presentation: please ensure hand written work is written in a pencil and colouring is done in colouring pencil or pen.

Please keep your Home learning points sheet in your home learning folder. If sheets are lost we will have some spares, however be careful with it, as it holds the record of your points!

<b>For 1 point</b>		
Write out your address neatly on an envelope.		
<b>For 2 points</b>		
Learn the names of the 3 primary colours and the 3 secondary colours.		
Write down the names of 5 towns or villages near where you live, remembering to use a capital letter for the name of a place.		
Learn to count confidently backwards from 100 to 0.		
Write down your daily routine with times, using o'clock and half past .		
Measure items in your home and record how long they are in centimetres and metres.		
<b>For 5 Points</b>		
Draw a map of your journey to school.		
Go for a walk and make a note or drawing of sounds you hear in different places, eg in your bathroom, at the park, around the shops.		

Draw a picture of your house and label some of the materials which it is made from.		
Explore colour mixing using paint and find what colours can be made by mixing two or more of red, yellow and blue.		
Explore fractions by cutting things into halves and quarters half (eg a cake). Bring in a photo of what you did.		
Make something from materials which would otherwise be thrown away, eg a model from packaging or an instrument from yoghurt pots.		
Write a diary entry about something that you did at the weekend.		
Go on to the Five Sentence challenge website <a href="http://fivesc.net/">http://fivesc.net/</a> to see the latest prompt. Write 5 interesting sentences inspired by this.		
<b>For 10 Points</b>		
Write an adventure story related to your neighbourhood. Present this as a book.		
Learn a poem by heart and recite it to the class.		
Go on a garden safari, and record the different plants or trees in which you can see.		
Create a collage using natural materials found in our local area.		
Make a boat that floats
